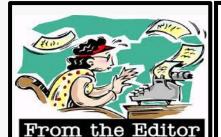

15 June - Years 10 and 12 back to school

We are working hard in school to prepare for the return of the first year groups – Y10 and 12 as per the government guidance. Y10 will be able to come in one day per week to have some face to face teaching in core subjects, and Y12 will be taught in their subject blocks. Each group will remain in their own 'bubble'. No class will be larger than 14 students (many much smaller) and specific classrooms are being used which have been marked out at 2m distancing and equipped with hand sanitiser, tissues, disinfectant and bin bags. You will get an idea from the photos. Even the school drive, canteen, entry and exit points are all marked out at 2m. We look forward to seeing some of our year groups back, but place the health and safety of all above everything. Our Caretaking team are doing an amazing job getting the site ready. Thank you.
