The Re-Opening of our Churches. (a) It is wonderful to welcome an increasing number of parishioners back to our celebrations of Holy Mass, & grateful thanks are extended to our Stewards for their help in implementing the systems of hygiene & infection control. Our attempts to keep everyone safe makes coming to Mass a different experience from what we think of as 'normal.' It reminds us that "we cannot simply return to how things were before Lockdown." **The Obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended** & therefore every Catholic is asked to think carefully about how & when they will return to Mass. Attending a weekday Mass may be an option, easing the pressure of numbers for Sundays. Numbers inside our buildings are very limited (the minimum number i.e. based on one person attending Mass alone is: **Holy Spirit 20 & St. Paul's 17** (with an additional **14 places for individuals**). These figures increase with family units sitting together & are based on social distancing of 2 meters. (b) **Weddings & Funerals.** We are now able to celebrate inside our churches but social distancing must be adhered to, & currently numbers for these occasions are not to exceed 30. (c) **Stewards.** If you can help (& are not in / living with anyone in a vulnerable category i.e. 70+) please contact Fr. Nicholas ASAP. (d) **Registration of Intention of Attend Mass.** To comply with government requirements those attending BOTH weekday & weekend Masses will be asked to supply their name & a contact number. This will be done as you prepare to enter church. This may assist the NHS Test & Trace with requests for data if needed for contact-tracing. To help with this it is possible to book seats on-line via either of our websites. **If you are booking seats for those you live with / or travel to church with please book tickets for "HOUSEHOLDS OF 2+" & not single seats for each member of your household. If you do the latter then those looking at the booking website will see that our churches have reached their capacity which will not actually be true!** Aware that not everyone has access to the internet a number of seats in both churches may be booked by telephone. To do this please contact Fr. Nicholas & if you leave a message on the answer-machine please give your 'phone number twice so that an accurate record may be kept for the NHS Test & Trace. It is important that ALL parishioners **arrive at church in plenty of time & not at the last minute!** **Sacred Times.** Those not yet attending Mass are encouraged to join our faith communities in prayer at the time Masses are being celebrated benefitting from the Spiritual Communion of the Liturgical Act being offered in our churches. A prayer that may help you benefit from Spiritual Communion is the Prayer of St. Alphonsus: *My Jesus, I believe that you are present in this Holy Sacrament of the altar. I love you above all things and I passionately desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, come spiritually into my soul so that I may unite myself wholly to you now and forever. Amen.*

Face Coverings. From NEXT Saturday 8th August face-coverings will need to be worn by all attending Mass.

Mass Intentions. These may be handed-in via the Collection Baskets or through either Presbytery letterbox.

Dial-A-Mass. A weekly Sunday Mass from Middlesbrough Cathedral is being recorded for the benefit of those without the internet. As the Mass is recorded, it can be listened to at anytime on 01642—130120 (charged at your usual rate).

VJ Commemoration. The Royal British Legion will be leading an Act of Commemoration in the Memorial Park at Cleckheaton on Saturday 15th August beginning at 10.50 am in order to be able to observe a two minutes silence at 11.00 am.

First Holy Communion / Reconciliation. The parents of children in Years 4 & 5 (from September) at Holy Spirit School will be invited to a meeting in the early weeks of the new academic year to discuss plans for the celebration of these Sacraments originally planned to be celebrated in Lent and June, but postponed due to Lockdown.

Sick Visits. Currently Fr. Nicholas can only undertake **emergency** & **urgent** house-calls at the request of families.

Finances. Currently our churches are each losing an income of approx. £1,000 per month owing to the lack of the weekly Loose Collection (i.e. contributed by parishioners without envelopes). To help make contributions easier to make we now have **Text Giving** through which it is possible to make a contribution of £5.00 to our Parish collections by Text Giving; simply text CHURCH HEC to 70500 (for Holy Spirit) or text CHURCH CLEC to 70500 (for St. Paul's). There is also a Donate Button on our webpage for direct giving.
