Heritage Open Days 2022. Thank you to those who attended the meeting held on Wednesday evening & for those who are working behind the scenes on various projects associated with the Heritage Open Days. For those involved with the St. Paul's Open Day (Saturday 10th September 10 a.m.—3.00 p.m) the setting-up process will begin on Wednesday 31st August at 6.00 p.m. At Holy Spirit a similar preparatory process will be held on Tuesday 13th September at a time yet to be confirmed. The dates of the Open Days in Heckmondwike are Friday 16th September (12 noon—4.00 p.m.) & Saturday 17th September (10.00 a.m.—2.00 p.m. More stewards at Holy Spirit would be welcomed. The role is primarily about welcoming visitors, overseeing displays on the Open Day, & answering any questions they may have. N.B. Items relating to the history of either of our churches that could be of interest to other parishioners / visitors would be welcomed in preparation for this new venture. This can be done at anytime (30 mins. max.) via the link https://kirklees.event-booking.org.uk/elearning-list Once on the site create an account & complete the course entitled: "An awareness of child abuse and neglect". When completed you will be awarded a certificate; a copy of which will need to be given to our Parish Safeguarding Representative / Fr. Nicholas.
