<u>Home Visits for Holy Communion</u>. If parishioners would like to receive Holy Communion at home they or a family member are asked to contact Fr. Nicholas directly. Prior to any visit Fr. Nicholas will take a Covid Test & observe protocols that continue to be in place in residential / nursing homes.

<u>Churches Together in Cleckheaton</u>.
