First Sacramental Preparation for Children in Non-Catholic Schools. The names & contact details of children in Non-Catholic education are now being sought in order to begin their Sacramental preparation in 2023. The details of Year 3+ (Reconciliation), Year 4+ (1st Holy Communion) & Year 6 (Confirmation) children may be given to Fr. Nicholas. The basic expectation is that these children & their parents will be regular church attendees & be familiar with the Mass. <u>Sacrament of Confirmation for Holy Spirit School Children</u>. Preparation of our Year 6 children for the Sacrament of Confirmation (to be celebrated as a Deanery on <u>January 26th 2023</u>) is underway. The expectation is that these children & their families will attend a weekend Mass; last weekend 6 out of 21 children attended Mass. <u>Home Visits for Holy Communion</u>. If parishioners would like to receive Holy Communion at home they or a family member are asked to contact Fr. Nicholas directly. Prior to any visit Fr. Nicholas will take a Covid-19 Test & observe protocols that continue to be in place in some residential / nursing homes.

**Food Bank Donations.** Receptacles are available at the back of both of our churches for donations of food / toiletries. **N.B.** Any <u>financial</u> contributions made to the Cleckheaton Food Bank until the <u>end of January 2023</u> will be doubled through the partnership that the Food Bank has with "Match it!"
