Nicholas will take a Covid-19 Test & observe protocols that continue to be in place in some residential / nursing homes.

<u>Another Bishop from the Diocese</u>. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has appointed Monsignor Philip Moger (currently Rector of the National Shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham) as an Auxiliary Bishop in the Archdiocese of Southwark, to assist Archbishop John Wilson (a former Priest of the Diocese of Leeds) in his ministrations. Msgr. Moger served as Dean of Leeds Cathedral for a number of years, & was formerly a Parish Priest in Bradford & Leeds.
