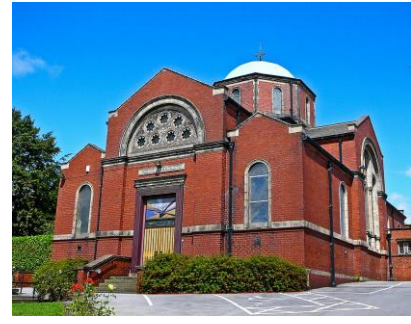
Happy Christmas!
