The details of the venues & times of our Holy Week Liturgies are as follows: Holy Thursday (6th April) The Mass of the Lord's Supper (& Watching until 9.00 p.m.) will take place at Holy Spirit beginning at 7.00 p.m.; Good Friday (7th April) the Commemoration of the Lord's Passion will take place at St. Paul's at 3.00 p.m.; Stations of the Cross will be reflected upon at Holy Spirit at 7.00 p.m.; The (only) Vigil & First Mass of Easter (8th April) will take place at Holy Spirit at 6.30 p.m. These details are on display on our websites & the external Noticeboards of both churches.
